Owners, Brian and Leslie Axdahl provide quality produce for residents, grocery stores and restaurants they grow themselves along with other vegetables on 450 acres.

For those who drive past [Axdahl's Garden Farm & Greenhouse](#) located on the corner of Manning Avenue and County Road 12 and have never stopped to check out the place, it may be time to reconsider.

Axdahl's has some of the [freshest produce](#), [best sweet corn](#) and [most beautiful potted plants and hanging baskets](#) in the area.

"We grow most of everything we sell," Leslie Axdahl says. "The few things we don't grow we get from partners farmers."

New this year to Axdahl's is a [community supported agriculture program \(CSA\)](#), where for a fee, members receive a box of fresh produce for 20 weeks over the growing season.

The CSA program is a great way to support land stewardship and enjoy the benefit of healthy eating and an opportunity to try different vegetables, Axdahl says. Axdahl's is certified sustainable by the [Food Alliance Midwest](#) and is committed to implanting earth-friendly practices. Members have the option to purchase a full share or half share and can pickup their produce or have it delivered.

Fresh produce isn't the only thing happening at Axdahl's.

It's also a fun fall destination for the family from hayrides to the pick-your-own pumpkin patch and a corn maze. For the little ones there's kid-friendly miniature horses and goats, and a potbelly pig for petting. For the older kids, this year there's a hunted trail and corn maze.

Part of the proceeds will go to PACER's National Bullying Prevention Center, an organization the Axdahl's strongly support.

For more information about the fall festivities and the hours and dates call (651) 439-3134. Axdahl's operation continues through the Christmas season, when they sell freshly cut Balsam and Fraser trees, wreaths, holiday decorations and garlands.
